Re: Sefton Medicines Management Pharmacy Hub Roll-Out

The Sefton Medicines Management hub has been successfully piloted for GP practices in the Crosby/Waterloo and North Southport localities in Sefton.

We now plan to extend this service to other GP practices in Sefton, for the Medicines Management Hub to deal with any medication related queries from the GP/Reception/ Patient/Carer or any other Healthcare Professional. This will be a phased roll-out to each Primary Care Network (PCN)/locality over the next few months, starting with GP practices in Maghull, see table below;

This phased roll-out will start Monday 2nd September 2019 and community pharmacies will be able to contact the hub directly with medication related queries, for patients that are registered with any GP practices in a PCN that has gone live.

It is important to complete the pro-forma in full, to ensure that we have all the relevant information about each query and not using the pro-forma may result in a delayed response.

Please note the hub is available between the hours of 9.00 am and 1.00 pm Monday to Friday. Outside of these hours, where possible, please contact the GP practice directly with any urgent queries. For non-urgent queries/out of stock issues, please email the hub in the usual way and these will be dealt with the following working day.

Please note; From Thursday 29th August, the previous telephone contact numbers and email addresses used for the hub pilot will NOT be operational.

Queries suitable for review by the HUB include;

- General medication queries
- Medication availability issues
- Repeat Dispensing (RD) issues
- Post hospital discharge medication related queries
- Medication adherence issues
- Compliance Aid requests

Queries NOT suitable for review by the HUB include;

- Patient has run out of medication and requires a prescription
- Requests to issue any prescriptions
- Routine medication reviews

We hope that this new way of working will support current working relationships between all colleagues involved in helping patients with their medication and provide a more timely resolution to patient queries.
